The list of courses keep changing till the course registration starts.

The Beginning of the Course Registration Period

- Spring Semester : Late February
- Fall Semester : Late August


The draft of the list of courses is available earlier. We provide international students with this draft in the excel file format.

Since the list constantly changes, it is necessary to check the list of courses in the course search system. For details, please see other questions in this FAQ.




Procedure

- 1. Access the website at http://sugang.inha.ac.kr
- 2. Click 'ENGLISH' on the upper right side.
- 3. Click 'Course Schedule' under 'Curriculum' on the left side menu.




Procedure

- 4. Choose 'foreign language' in the 'Etc' bar. All courses on the list are taught in foreign languages.
- 5. Please check the 'Note'. Courses with 'English' for the Note would be offered in English. If it says 'Chinese', then that courses will be offered in Chinese






Do not use and select 'Department/Major' menu. If you use it, the English setting for 'etc' menu will be initialized. In other words, there's no way to see only particular major courses offered in English.



If you select a particular department, then setting is initialized so that it shows all courses offered by the department regardless of instruction language.

Empty blank for 'Note' means that the course will be taught in Korean.





If you click the 'blue' course number, then you will be able to see the syllabus. If there's no syllabus linked to a course, it is marked in gray




What is the restricted courses?

Restricted courses are the courses allowed only to a specific majors. For example, if your major is mechanical engineering, you can enroll a mathematics course offered by the department of Mechanical Engineering but cannot enroll the mathematics course offered by the department of Economics if the mathematics course of the Economics is a restricted course. In other words, the restricted courses for a particular major are available only to the students of that major.
